Final meeting of partners in Bradford

On March 28-29, 2023, the final meeting of the partners of the STAY+ project took place in Bradford, UK. The main topic was the **sharing of experience from the piloting** of the created mobile platform in partner countries, analyzing the feedback from teachers and secondary school students with a focus on managing the platform, graphics, content-topics of well-being, methods of obtaining digital rewards. Particular steps to spread the STAY+ platform to the widest possible audience were discussed.



Multiplier events

Face-to-face multiplier events were held during April 2023 in partner countries for disseminating Stay platform and other results to the target audience: VET learners and VET professionals (teachers, trainers, special teachers, school psychologists).

Conferences meet with positive feedback, Stay+ results are considered as a good quality, useful and freely available for further use by a target group.



Audience highlighted a Stay+ platform concept; its attractive and user-friendly graphic design, interesting content, gaining badges and levels of difficulties. Platform has a good potential of sustainability and adaptation in other contexts (other areas of wellbeing as community, environmental wellbeing etc.)
